The regular meeting of the Columbia Falls Aluminum Company (CFAC) Community Advisory Panel (CAP) was conducted as a tour of the site. The event occurred on Wednesday, May 9, 2018. Mike Ritorto presented a project overview and update before the tour began. The participants boarded buses and visited the e Potroom 1 basement area, which had been filled with soil material from an onsite permitted excavation source. The participants also observed Potroom 2 basement which has not been filled with soil material. Next, interested tour attendees visited a monitoring well installation site and Roux explained the process for installing and developing a groundwater monitoring well.
